"Typical Day"

- Building open for students to enter at 7:15 am
- Breakfast served at 7:30 am
- Warning bell 7:46 am
- 1st period begins at 7:50 am
- Each class period 47-50 minutes
- 4 minutes between each class staggered bells
- 7 Period schedule plus lunch
- Majority of 7th grade classes are on the 1st floor
- Students divided into four Teams A, B, C, D
- Three mixed grade level lunch periods (4th period lunch = 10:19-10:49, 6th period lunch = 11:10-11:40, 8th period lunch = 12:01-12:31)
- Jacket Period 25 minute period at the end of each day
 Monday-Friday = Meaningful Silent Reading (MSR) all students
- Dismissal = 2:45 pm



Academics



Each student will already have the following classes on their schedule:

- English/Language Arts Full Year (Students that are already taking a Gifted ELA class @ HPI will be scheduled in the JH Gifted ELA class)
- 2. Social Studies Full Year
- 3. **Science** Full Year
- 4. **Math** Full Year (Parents are informed by HPI if their child is recommended to be in an accelerated math class. A recommendation is required and students must achieve district benchmarks to be accelerated in math.)
- 5. **Health -** 1 Semester and **Physical Education** 1 Semester

Elective Options

- Band, Orchestra, Choir All are full year and can take two.
 - Class will meet every day



- FAIS = Foreign Culture (Spanish, French, Chinese) *The Foreign Culture is randomly assigned, Art, Industrial Technology, And STEM.
 - Each class meets for 1 quarter (9 Weeks)
 - Classes are scheduled in a random order
 - Provides opportunity to have four different classes throughout the year
- Academic Study Full Year
 - Opportunity for students to complete assignments, read, or work on group projects during the school day

Intervention Supports

- English/Language Arts Lab
- Math Lab
- Multi-sensory Reading Lab (Wilson)
 - Teacher Recommendation Pass/Fail
 - Can also be requested by parent/guardian
 - Standardized Test Scores (Air/STAR)
 - Takes the place of an elective
 - Parents notified by letter
 - Can be adjusted during year
 - Meet Monday-Friday


